Chapter Education Fund

Help Our Active Brothers Become Great Leaders

The primary goal of our Chapter Education Fund is to help our young Cal Zeta actives become great leaders.

Every year up to 5% of the fund is paid out to the active brothers for leadership school tuition and academic scholarships. Since the education fund began in 2008, we have made 92 awards for a total of \$44,858 (\$16,090 for scholarships and \$28,768 for leadership school tuitions). The actives who attend leadership school, learn about the history of our fraternity and meet brothers from all over the U.S.A. The active brothers return to our chapter with renewed enthusiasm and loyalty to ΣAE , displaying high energy and improved leadership skills.

Since we created the CEF in 2008:

- Our brothers have contributed \$149,000
- Investment income \$62,000
- Scholarships and awards to the active brothers \$45,000
- Management fees paid to the ΣAE foundation \$14,000
- Value of the CEF as of 6/30/2020 is \$152,000






